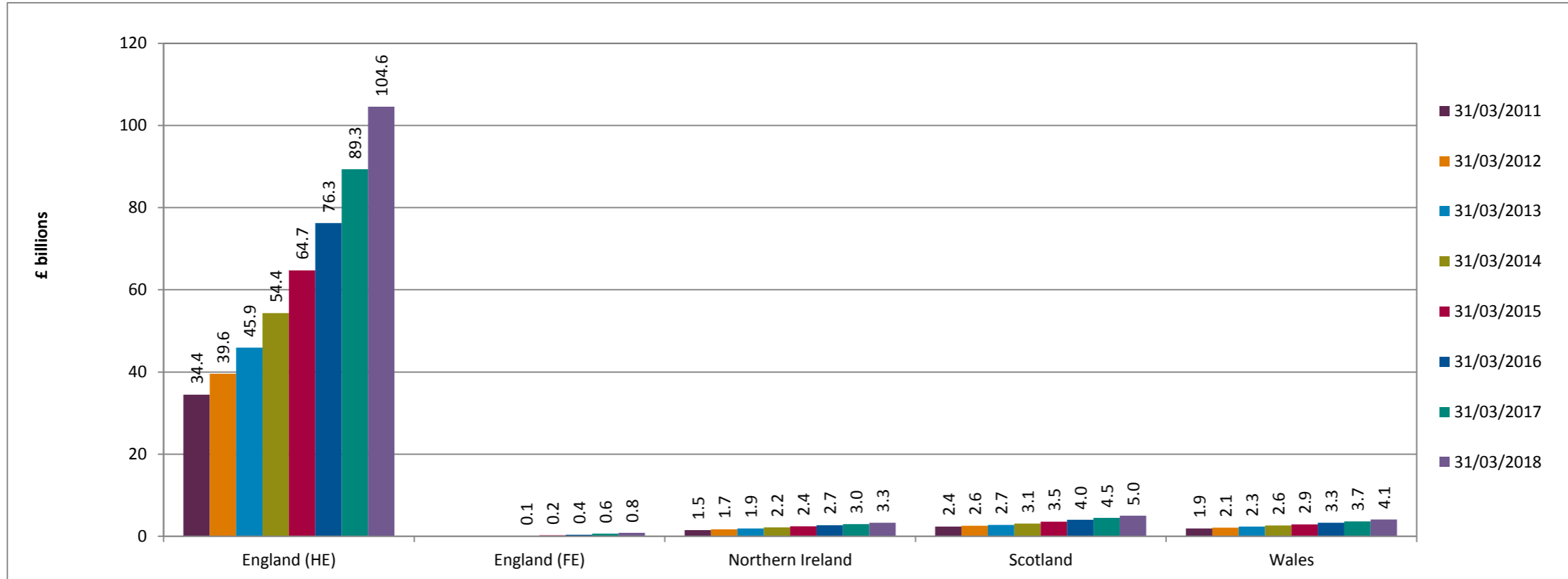


Student Loans - Loan Balance

The outstanding balance is increasing for all Government Administrations. At this point in time the new lending and the interest added outweighs the repayments being made by those borrowers who are now liable to repay.
